ORDINANCE 08-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL, ALASKA, REVISING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 18.16.050, HARBOR RATE SCHEDULES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL:

Section 1. Classification. Section 2 of this ordinance shall become a permanent part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Saint Paul, Alaska.

Section 2. Amendment. City Ordinance Chapter XVIII, Boat Harbor Facilities, Section 18.16.050, Other Harbor Facilities Fees, shall be repealed and revised to read as follows:

Rates and fees for harbor facilities shall be recommended by the City Manager and approved by the City Council, shall be posted in the Harbormaster's office and available upon request in the City Finance Department.

The attached document lists initial fees to be effective upon adoption of this ordinance..

Section 3. Severability. As provided in the City Code of Ordinances Chapter I, Section 1.7, Severability, if any portion of this ordinance is subsequently found to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts of this ordinance.

Section 4. Duration. This ordinance shall remain in effect until revised by the City Council in accordance with the procedures set forth in Chapter I, Section 1.8, Amendments to the Code.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately following its adoption by the City Council.

Sounding Security	It is unlawful for any vessel to enter the Port of St. Paul without sounding security. Any vessel not adhering to this clause will be issued a Level II fine (City code of ordinances: Chapter VIII, City Offenses).	
Maneuvering within Harbor	It is unlawful for any vessel more than 46' LOA to maneuver within the Port of St. Paul without notifying the Harbormaster or Public Safety Department. Any vessel not adhering to this clause will be issued a Level II fine (City code of Ordinances: Chapter VIII, City Offenses).	
No Wake Zone	It is unlawful for any vessel entering the port of St. Paul to create "wakes" within the confines of the harbor. Any vessel not adhering to this clause will be issued a Level II fine (City code of ordinances: Chapter VIII, City Offenses).	

Vessels/Companies with past due accounts may be denied access into the Port of St. Paul.
