ENACTING ORDINANCE 18-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL, ALASKA, REVISING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER X PUBLIC WORKS; SECTION 10.03 RATES OF SERVICE; SUBSECTIONS 10.03.01 WATER UTILITY AND 10.03.02 SEWER UTILITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance amends existing provisions of the City's Code of Ordinances. Section 2 of this ordinance shall become a permanent part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Saint Paul.

Section 2. Amendment. The rates and fees for the Water and Sewer Utility shall be recommend by the City Manager and approved by the City Council by resolution. Approval of the resolution shall require two (2) readings of the City Council. The new rates will be added to the City Master Rate Schedule and posted for the public.

Section 3. Amendment. Section 10.03.01 of the City Code of Ordinances, Rate of Service Fixed, shall be repealed and revised as presented in the attached document showing what clauses are to be deleted and the replacement clause.

Section 4. Amendment. Section 10.03.02 of the City Code of Ordinances, Rate of Service Fixed, shall be repealed and revised as presented in the attached document showing what clauses are to be deleted and the replacement clause.

Section 5. Severability. As provided in the City Code of Ordinances Chapter I, Section 1.7 Severability, if any portion of this ordinance is subsequently found to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts of this ordinance.

Section 6. Duration. This ordinance shall remain in effect until revised by the City Council in accordance with the procedures set forth in Chapter I, Section 1.8, Amendments to the Code.

Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately following its adoption by the City Council.

CHAPTER X – PUBLIC WORKS

SECTION 10.01. ORGANIZATION.

There shall be a public works department in and for the City to be known as the City of Saint Paul Public Works Department. It shall consist of a Public Works Director and as many other employees as may be deemed necessary for the effective operation of the division.

SECTION 10.02. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT.

The responsibilities of the Public Works Department shall include the following.

- A. Garbage collection and disposal service.
- B. Maintenance of all established roadways within the City.
- C. Water utilities.
- D. Maintenance of the airstrip. Director shall recommend and City Manager shall approve all airstrip service charges.
- E. Operation and maintenance of power and light utility.
- F. Other public services as from time to time may be deemed necessary for the good of the public that are within the capabilities of the Department.

SECTION 10.03. RATES OF SERVICE

10.03.01. Water Utility.

Rates and Fees for Water Utility shall be recommended by the City Manager and approved by the City Council. The new rates will be added to the City of Saint Paul Master Rate Schedule and posted publicly.

10.03.04. The City Council shall sit as the Public Works Utility Board to hear and judge all appeals regarding utility rate charges.

SECTION 10.04. COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENT.

All heads of households and/or places of business, governmental or other units, are required to comply with the provisions of this Chapter.

SECTION 10.05. FAILURE TO COMPLY.

Any head of household and/or place of business, governmental or other unit, who willfully fails, neglects, or refuses to comply with the provisions of this Chapter, upon conviction, is guilty of a City offense and is punishable as set forth in CCO 8.02.
