



A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH SUBSISTENCE HUNTING AREAS

WHEREAS on June 1971 the City boundaries were incorporated as the entire island, including Sealion Rock, and

WHEREAS in 1986 Otter and Walrus Islands, as well as three nautical miles surrounding the three islands, were annexed and added to the incorporated boundaries, and

WHEREAS City Ordinance 8.6.1 states that it is against the law to discharge firearms in the City limits, and

WHEREAS areas need to be established to protect the hunters from breaking the law, yet allowing for subsistence hunting,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Saint Paul that the Council shall adopt Map Number Three (titled "Subsistence Activities") to implement subsistence hunting areas and allow the discharge of firearms for the purposes of hunting marine mammals and land mammals, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Saint Paul adopt Map Number Four (titled "Subsistence Activities -- Avian and Berries") to implement subsistence hunting areas and allow the discharge of firearms for the purposes of hunting waterfowl.
